Also, thank you goes out to the many individuals who prepared, cooked, and served the delicious authentic meal.

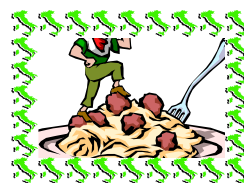
Without the involvement and commitment of all the volunteers, it would have not been possible. But most importantly we want to thank all those that attended and supported the event.
